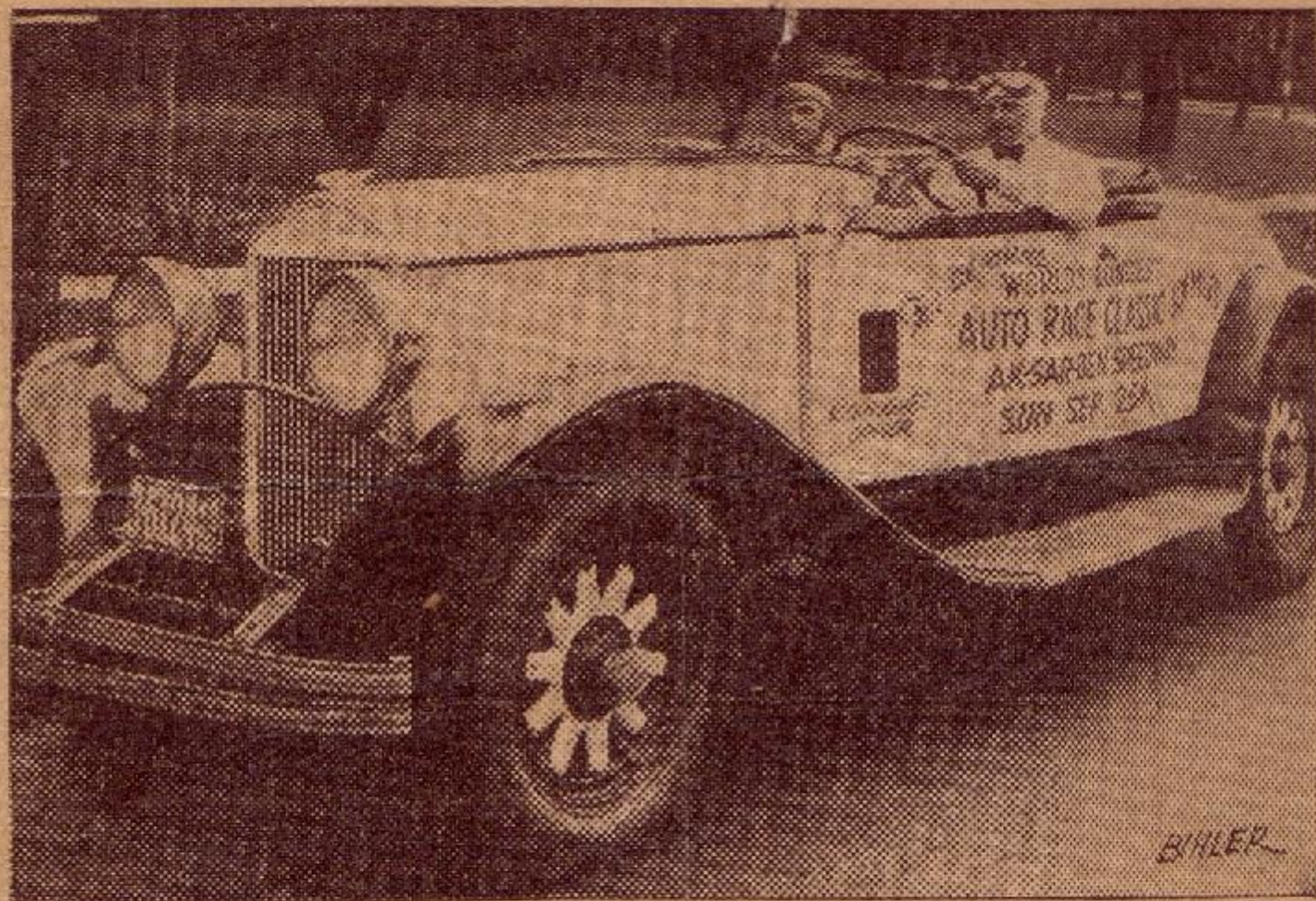


EXPECTS TO RACE 250 MILES SUNDAY
