# HOT 100

We have a great route planned for this years HOT 100. The start and finish will be at the Les Schwab store on Hwy 26 at the west end of Sandy, Oregon. There will be plenty of trailer parking available and the after event refreshments will be right next door at Paolas Pizza Barn. The route will take you in and out of three river drainages. All roads are paved and most are little traveled. There are lots of elevation changes and curves to make things interesting. A snack and coffee stop will be included in the route near the halfway point. Pizza and beverages will be supplied by the club at the finish.

We would like to extend a special invitation and challenge to the out of town members to come and take the rotating trophy home. Since the winner also gets to put on the event next year at the location of their choosing we would also urge all the drivers on the east side of town to come out and try to keep the event over here.

Time: 9:00 Meet at Les Schwab's parking lot.

9:10 Drivers meeting

9:30 First car out

?:?? Cars return to start area.

Presentation of the rotating trophy as soon as the winner is determined.

No problem for those coming from Seattle area to be home for dinner.

Scoring: One point for each second late at the finish.

Two points for each second early at the finish

2500 points for missing a checkpoint

Low score wins.

Ideal time has been set with Mike Hatley's stock Model A. 5 minutes has been added for the coffee break. Since your speedster is most likely faster up the hills (and there are a lot of them) than Mikes Model you will be able to take a longer coffee break. You will have to decide just how long.

As with all NWVS events, the HOT 100 is limited to 1934 and earlier based 4 cylinder speedsters. You will be responsible to carry current insurance and to have inspected your car for safety and roadworthiness before the event. All traffic laws are to be obeyed. Any traffic violation during the event will result in disqualification.

A trouble trailer will be provided to return broken cars to the start area.

Pre registration is not required, but we would appreciate it if you would call or e-mail and let us know you are coming so we can make arrangements for food.
