North By Northwest Spokane, Washington Sept 3 & 4, 2011

You are invited to participate in the 29th annual NWVS classic speedster endurance run. All pre 1934 four banger speedsters are invited. There will also be a lowland tour that will travel a similar route and will enjoy the same programs as the speedsters. We will be headquartered near Spokane for the Labor Day weekend event and will enjoy the great weather and scenery of Eastern Washington.

The Speedster Run will be based at the Spokane Airport Ramada Inn about 5 miles west of Spokane. Room rates are a special reduced "Speedster Run" rate of \$67.00 per room for one or two beds. The facility includes an award winning restaurant, lounge, exercise room, outdoor pool, an indoor waterpark /pool with a 108 ft. water slide and a Jacuzzi. There will be free on-site parking for your speedster, towing vehicle, and trailer! There is a nearby Wal-Mart Super Store and a variety of sit-down and fastfood restaurants, retail stores, a theater, and hardware/automotive stores. Also, there are several service stations within a mile of the motel, including a nearby Spokane Indian Tribe owned gas station selling fuel at significantly reduced prices.

When making reservations at the Ramada Inn, call locally at 509-838-5211 and ask for the "<u>Speedster</u><u>Run</u>" special rate. (Note – calling the Ramada toll-free 800 number hooks you up to their national reservation desk which may not be able to offer you the special reduced rate, so we suggest calling the motel direct at their local Spokane number). On Saturday, we will have a hospitality room in the hotel for snacks, refreshments, and socializing. In the morning, we will have a courtesy technical safety inspection for each speedster. In the afternoon, there will be a short tour and a visit to a local special interest attraction. On Sunday, we will enjoy a beautiful and interesting speedster run followed by a superb banquet that evening.

Entry fee will be \$150.00 for the car, driver and navigator. Fees will include the Saturday hospitality room, Sunday morning break, lunch, evening banquet and two handsome embroidered patches. Also included is a continental breakfast Sunday and Monday morning in the hospitality room.

Safety Rules

Owners and drivers are responsible for making certain that cars are in good condition and are safely operated. To qualify for entry, all entrants must sign disclaimer and owners/drivers must provide proof of Public Liability and Property Damage Insurance which will be in effect during the run.

SELF INSPECTION AND COURTESY CHECK DETAIL:

To qualify for entry, all cars must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Any modification to stock chassis must be equal or superior to the original in service and durability.
- 2. No part of the frame, undercarriage, engine or running gear can extend below the wheel rims.
- 3. Service and parking brakes must be in good working order.
- 4. All cars must have a working brake lamp(s).
- Cars having auxiliary transmission or two speed rear ends MUST be equipped with an effective rear hub braking system. In the case of the 26/27 Model T, lined internal hub brakes qualify, <u>earlier internal hub brakes</u>, even though lined, DO NOT QUALIFY.
- 6. Reasonable true, tight wheels. IF THEY ARE LOOSE DO NOT EVEN CONSIDER ENTERING, YOU WILL BE DISQUALIFIED. NO EXCEPTIONS!!
- 7. At least 3/32" tread on all tires. No dry rot or excessive rubber cracking.
- 8. Rear wheels must be tight on axles.
- 9. Front wheel bearings must be properly adjusted with correct locking washer and cotter pin.
- 10. No under play in the steering wheel system, including the drag link, tie rod, spindles, etc. Model T steering gear cover must be secured with a screw if stock.
- 11. All cars must be equipped with a firewall.
- 12. The steering column must be mounted in two places.
- 13. Wraparound seats with outside walls must be high enough and strong enough to hold occupant in place.
- 14. Seat frame must be **bolted** to body and/or car frame. Body **bolted** to car frame with appropriately graded bolts, nuts and lock washers.
- 15. All cotter pins, safety wires, lock washers and lock nuts in place.
- 16. All raw metal edges and cowling must be protected with a suitable edging.
- 17. All hoods securely held down.
- 18. All glass (except head/taillight lenses) must be safety glass.
- 19. Exhaust pipes must be secured to body or frame.
- 20. Authentic style gas tanks, secured to, with at least two straps, to body or frame.
- 21. Fully charged, appropriately rated, operable fire extinguisher, readily available, must be carried at all times.
- 22. Owner/Driver solely responsible for safety of vehicle.

A FINAL NOTE:

Please remember, THIS IS NOT A ROAD RACE, IT IS AN AUTOMOBILE ENDURANCE RUN.

The better prepared your car, the better chance of finishing. Legal or safe driving speeds sustained over the entire run will have the best chance of winning. Careless or reckless drivers will be <u>disqualified</u> and not allowed to participate in future events.

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- 1. Every nut and bolt on the front end, rear end, chassis, and body is to be secured with a visible lock washer, or cotter pin. Especially check the entire steering mechanism.
- 2. Model T's with wishbone connection is to be safety wired together, so neither stud can turn out.
- 3. Model T's with stock steering gear must have a set screw in the cover, and have tight steering with no shimmy on the front end.
- 4. Body must be securely bolted to the frame and seats bolted to the body or frame.
- 5. A fuel shut off valve at the tank and carburetor is not mandatory, but is strongly suggested.
- 6. A hand hold for the mechanic is also strongly suggested on open bodied cars.
